1. Interrogation was designed to bring out details of JANKA dealings with Buero BLANK, and other similar accordes, apart from those concerned with the handling of the stolen locuments.

2. End 50JAINKE sent papers on the following military subjects to his old CG; Gen Heinrich & ABACH:-

Discipline and Orill for Recruits,
The Part of the Infantryman in Arms marfare,
The composition of Arms Fighting Ope with
Commandos, Air Strike Wings and Parachutists,
The Defence of Europe against the East.

Those papers were passed into Buern BLAK by EEERBUCH Jun at the beg 51, and JAHKU later heard that they had received flattering attention. However, he was not called to personally enlarge on them.

JAHRKE kept the HV in Cafe ERANZLER, duly meeting a certain BEPACK, who, on hearing JAHRKE's business, regretted that he had no source in the local EPD.

JARKE visited Buero BLANK to pick up EEERBACH jun. EBERBACH was out and, while JARKE was writing, BEINZ came into the vestibule, greeted JARKE and, assuming that JARKE had called to pay the premised visit, took him into his office. Here he showed JARKE a map pinned to a supposed, which bore a number sabalistic signs and which he described as propered by OSTER under his direction to show the extent of their espionage operations. Gen EBERBACH communicated these facts to JARREL and asked him to attend a council of war in BAD DOLL, enaloging DM 50 travelling expenses.
