and MUNSTER, taking doctorate of philosophy in
1927.

1928-29

First and second State science examination for
teaching at higher schools.

1930-31

Studien Assessor in DUISBURG.

1931-32

Studien Assessor at German school in AITENS.

1932-35

Reader at State University, YAMAGUCHI, JAPAN.

1935-37

Assistant in Faculty of Philosophy at University
of HEIDELBERG.

1937

Married Annemarie GLISSEN, née KOCH.

1937

Doctorate of habilitation taken in order to
become university lecturer (Dozent).

1937-42

Lecturer (Dozent) on Philosophy and Political
Science at University of HEIDELBERG.

Since 1942

Professor extraordinary for philosophy and
political science at University of HEIDELBERG.

4. Military

1938

Three months trip as private with LN Regt 12 in
FRANKFURT/MAIN.

1938-40

Called up to LN Regt 12 and saw service in
"Westwall".

1940

Given leave to join party of German academicians
on a six months' visit to JAPAN, sponsored by
the Japanese Govt.

1941

Exempted from military service in representations
from University of HEIDELBERG and Ministry of
Education of BADEN.

1942

Called up as Gefr to LN Regt LC 3, DEANVILLE,
FRANCE.

1942-Oct 44

Transferred as Uffz to OKW Dept Army Propaganda,
Section P.R. E.M.I, reporting on Japanese theatres
of war and making analyses of enemy propaganda
(British and American).

Oct 44-Apr 45

Transferred to LN Regt KUGELBERG and att to
Bat VI C 4 ESKL, evaluating for Eastern front and
publishing regular reports.

21 Apr 45

Married flight from DEANVILLE by car, with out a
fixed destination, in company with other officers
of Bat VI.

- 3 May 45 Went to FLENSBURG, as news of the formation of the DÖNITZ Govt was received en route. In FLENSBURG Prisoner was taken into the new Govt by Major S von DAVIDSCHE, Majt to Adm DÖNITZ, but he had a function of any importance.
- May 45-15 Jun 45 In the DÖNITZ camp in FLENSBURG under British surveillance.
- 15 Jun 45 Presented himself at offices of P33 845 (?) FLENSBURG where he was arrested.

5. Political

- 1934 Became member of NSDAP, AO JAPAN (overseas organization, JAPAN) and affiliated organizations: NSV, NSLB, NS Dozentenbund.
- 1937 Appointed honorary Ostuf with orders to lecture on JAPAN in SS Oberabschnitt SÜDWEST. Prisoner states that he never held office within the Party.


