The files of the State Department were re-examined on 30 April 1952 at the suggestion of the FBI that they had information relating to our Subject.

The files of the Security, Foreign Correlation, and Visa Divisions were searched with negative results. The files of DC/R contained a letter from the U.S. Political Adviser of Germany, Frankfurt, 29 March 1946 to the Department, transmitting a detailed report by one Dr. Wilhelm -----, University of Heidelberg, received from a British source regarding the Far Eastern questions and dealing with relevant material gathered about Japanese personalities by German observation and experience. The report contained very detailed information regarding Ambassador Oshima and his staff. Dr. ----- further advised that if British authorities--in particular the Far Eastern Department of Secret Service--wished to open up a new information section embracing Far Eastern questions he would suggest collaboration with following persons owing to their specialist knowledge and their experience in making intelligence reports:

Legationsrat Dr. K. O. Braum, formerly in charge Far Eastern  
Department of Foreign Office  
Herr Karl Zahl, former general, Secretary to German-Jap  
Society in Berlin  
Herr Joern Leo, former RSHA referent on Jap question

Report of 23 September 1943 from Lisbon, Portugal recommended that the name of one Wilhelm -----, Avenida Palace Hotel, Lisbon, Portugal be deleted from Proclaimed list of Blocked Nationals inasmuch as he had returned to Germany shortly after his specification and had not since returned to Portugal.

The files contained no further information in the name of the Subject.
