The Prof. CLASSEN mentioned in paragraph 4 of reference is Prof. Dr. Wilhelm CLASSEN (b. 28 October 1903 in St. Joris bei Krefeld). We are anxious to learn where in the [redacted] complex [redacted] is now employed.
