According to carded information and personal observation by the undersigned, personal descriptions of the two Subjects follow: (NOTE: For true identities, see referenced dispatch.)

SCHUETZ 1. V-2978: He was born 11 April 1907 in Weyen; his address is Stuttgart, Werastr. 63. He has a puffy face, quite deeply lined; appears to be about 50 years old; grey hair, combed back with the part on the side; speaks with a strong Rhineland accent. He is Chief of the Operational CE Section, under [unclear] DIRK who is Chief of Dienststelle 161's CI/CE Section, and has four case officers under him. He said that the case in question (UJ-IBOLLERY F 125) was the 31st matter which was currently being handled by his officers. He gave the impression of being a hard-working and shrewd CE officer. He and V-2665 mentioned several times the fact that they felt stifled by the bureaucracy and administration which towered over them. V-2978 seemed to be a happy mixture of the academic approach (he studied law at the University of Bonn) and the practical operational side. He enjoys his cognac and has the appearance of partaking in considerable quantity. During the war he was in the RSMA.

2. V-2665: He was born 9 February 1902 in Dresden. He was formerly a career police official, captured by the Italians. He decided that it would be preferable to become a staunch Roman Catholic and thereby gain favor from his captors to spending a long period of time in Italian captivity. His physical appearance reminds one of a penguin. He is about 5'7" tall and probably tips the scales at 190 lbs. He has sandy-colored hair and appears to be 52 or 53 years old. He has a round little figure; his most remarkable physical characteristic is his hands which are tiny and tapered. He speaks with a Saxonian accent, alleges to be a bachelor and does not smoke; however, he also devotes himself to cognac with guests. [unclear] KUPF-BACE comments that although V-2665 is an excellent case officer, he falls down on his written reports. He gave the undersigned the impression of being a qualified, experienced officer, quite self-assured and, by his own admission, able to approach an agent or a contact on whatever basis seems appropriate.
