> SYMOPSIS: UJ-DROLLERY # 125, which we vigated as probably our cost valuable East German CART operation, has fallen through due to the unreliability and independent attitude of the agent involved. CA-RUBIUS, who is still regarded with suspicion, will be kept in loose contact with his ZIPPER case officer; no attempt will be made to exploit him further, but attention will be paid to two leads which have come out of the case.

deliberate lie to his case officer. Further, he is guilty of improper operational conduct; i.e., appealing for outside support without prior notification to ZIPPER. Because there seems to be little reward in continuing a CART operation with such a dubious agent, a preliminary decision has been reached to drop any further attempts at the IVF through CANTITUS.

2. In early August, CARIBIES told his case officer, V-2665, that he was still unhappy about his treatment in West Germany. He complained that he had been bouncable and direct in his dealings with Western representatives and that in return he had been viewed with such suspicion that he had been forced to take a mental job in order to support himself. V-2665 told CARIBIES that his only hope for a better living in West Germany was full and housest cooperation with ZIPPER. Upon proof of his good will, ZIPPER would undertake to better his lot. This procise, however, apparently did not satisfy CARIBIES. On 7 August the agent wrote to the Bermstadt Verwaltungsgericht appealing for political recognition. 3. On the heels of this development, CMITHIUS was cought in a baid lie. PUB had received, through an intercept dated 8 August, information that Frau CAHIII-LUS planned to come to West Germany on 13 August, provided that her hadrand connurred. She had "legally" obtained an intercomal pass from the DER valid until 2 Suptember. CHRIMITS told v-2655 that his wife and daughter should has arrived to risit him on that date without his permission. 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- 7. From the above, FOR agrees with ETFFER that there is little point in continuing close contact with CANTHUR for the following ressons:

 - a. Too many people now know about the operation. b. CAMINIUS has deliberately violated operational orders.
 - He has been caught in at least one direct lie to his case officer.
 - The case poses many unresolved questions which could only be cleared up with the expenditure of much time and effort.
 - Even if CANTINIUS were a reliable agent, there is little promise that he will produce positive CART information for his Western principals.
 - f. His mental state is not confucive to the conduct of a double agent operation.
- 8. The problem now exists of what can be done with CAMINIUS. There is a risky chance that through various official commections of V-2665 and V-2978, an attecut could be cade to frighten him into confessing the real nature of his mission in West Germany. LCFLUFIZE could be used in a second attempt to get at the truth of the matter, but CAMMUS states that he expects to be FAUTTER'ed again. Since CAMMUS has estemaibly revealed to the various Mestern services the nature of his mission and his targets, he cannot be prosecuted for withholding security informa-tion. As far as we know, there is no law under which he can be prosecuted by the Americans insanuck as his targets have not threstened U. S. interests. If CANTHUS is allowed to recain free in West Germany, he will pose a security hazard. On the other hand, no agancy has the assets necessary to keep him under constant observation for an extended period of time. He is being blacklisted by MIFPER with West German industrial protection groups, but this is no guarantee that he will not be able to find a job of interest to the East as well as sufficiently rewarding to him.
- 9. We have discovered from intercepts that CAMHHUS has established a li-aison with Frau Anits-URBAH, currently living in Esilbrono, In Stahlbushl 15 (see PULL-1551). A letter dated 25 August from CAMHHUS to URBAH contained the follow-ing: (Both ZIPPER and POB are puzzled by the meaning of the German text.)
