German Prisoner Traces:

X CLEMENS (Hauptsturmfuehrer)

German: b. ca. 1904: Abt IV Sipo and SD Rome from March - June 44: probably first arrived in Rome Jan 44 from Berlin in connection with the organization of sabotage operations: was CC at Via Tasso, Rome, until 12.5.44, when KOEHLER replaced him; reported to be a very good organizer: formerly a Kripo officer and is said to boast of his knowledge of police work: 5'6" (168 cm): fat, fair hair, almost bald, large double chin, pendulous lower lip.

X CLEMENS (Kriminalkommissar)

German: b. ca. 1912. - Leiter Abt III Gestapo Prague in June 1940.

X CLEMENS (Kriminaloberassistent) Emil

German: reported in February 1944 to be a member of Abt IV A Sipo and SD Oslo: formerly in Abt IV C.

- Feb/Mar: Johannes CRAMER performed air travel for D. 161.
- 21 Mar: MR by [redacted] @ KUTZBACH told [redacted] that Carl SCHUETZ (V-2978), Fritz BUSCH (V-2982) and Subject are long-time friends. During WW II they all served together in the SP (Sicherheitspolizei). Of the three in @ KUTZBACH's opinion, Subject is the most reliable and probably would not be affected by anything which might happen to the other two.
- Apr: Note from Security Review: Subject; Oskar SICK (aka SOZIU) (V-2665.4); and Fritz BALTRUSCH (V-2665.5) all know each other - creating security problem.
- Apr: Duty rail travel, Hannover/Stuttgart/Oldenburg for Johannes CRAMER, NK 16-18772.
- 24 Jun: MR by [redacted] Subject was formerly a career police official, SP (Sicherheitspolizei), captured by Italians; became a staunch Roman Catholic in preference to spending a long time as prisoner of the Italians (uses his Catholicism frequently in contact with agents); physical appearance reminds one of a penguin; he is ca. 6' 7" tall and probably tips the scales at 190 lbs. Has sandy colored hair and appears to be ca. 52 or 53 yrs old. Has rotund little figure; most remarkable physical characteristic is his hands which are tiny and tapered; speaks with Saxonian accent; (married; but does not live with his wife); does not smoke; devotes himself to cigars with gusto. [redacted] comments that although Subject is an excellent case officer he falls down on written reports. Subject, however, impressed as being a qualified, experienced officer, quite self-assured and by his own admission able to approach an agent on a contact on [redacted] however basis desired appropriate.

- 20 Jul: MR by Haddon. Hans CLEMENS who was by profession a criminal investigator and thus presumably was known to ALBERT V-2660 (strong double agent who committed suicide), is a well thought of CE case officer of D.161.
- 4 Aug: Cover address: Hans KOTHANN, Stuttgart 3, Hauptstadt, Postlagernd
- 4 Nov: MR by [redacted] (Send to ME as [redacted] POB Internal staff notes under ECLA-27303, 3 Jan 56).

- Jan: Subject appeared on this month's payroll under Dienststelle 24.
- 3 Jan: [EGLA-17303.] (Forwarding MR of 4 Nov 55)
- 22 May: According to G FRIESEN, Subject was one of the best KSHA men in Italy during the war; operated in the north, attempting to get a line on OSS activity. Subject was responsible for a penetration of Ascham's office near Lausanne; the penetration was never caught (name not supplied). As a result of this, boast he saw reports on the OSS Swiss mission regularly.
- 23 May: Carl WILHELM, V-2978, being transferred to independent office with headquarters in Cologne. He is taking Hans CLEMENS with him who will establish a Handlungvertretung in Duesseldorf.
- Aug: EGM [4417] Possible that Subject may be also using the [G YELLER] in  
Aug: HULL [4418] representation attempt - re Soviet Embassy information.
