1. Forwarded as Attachment A is a sketch of UJDRUM's apartment. It is hoped that the sketch is reasonably accurate; the UPHILL who made it could not remember if the apartment is on the I or II Stock.

2. It appears probable that the apartment could be bugged from three sides as well as from apartments above and below it. UPHILL still has some checks running to determine which persons live in apartments contiguous to UJDRUM's. They are not sure when they will get the information, if they do get it, and suggest that you go ahead with your efforts and not wait for UPHILL's information.

3. We have been promised the take from telephone coverage on UJDRUM as soon as UPHILL starts receiving it from SMOTI. FLEMING requested the coverage on 4 August when he discussed the matter with a SMOTI representative. FLEMING also requested SMOTI's derogatory information on UJDRUM, since UPHILL heard some years ago that one of the reasons UJDROWSY was dropped by the British was because of his relationship with UJDRUM.
