1. The following notation was found in the personal papers of UTDRUM:

"Mr. and Mrs. Laurence \* HIRSCH  
c/o Celie DERSONN  
551 - 5th Avenue  
New York 17, N. Y."

DERSONN might not be quite correct, since the word is not quite legible.

2. UPHILL notes that the above item might have been written by one of the HIRSCHS, since it certainly is not in the handwriting of UTDRUM.

3. MLB has no identifiable traces on HIRSCH or DERSONN, and these names are also not known to UPHILL. It is requested that headquarters attempt to determine the nature of Subjects' contact with UTDRUM.
