2. UPHILL notes that the above item might have been written by one of the HIRSCHES, since it certainly is not in the handwriting of UJDRIK.

3. MILB has no identifiable traces on HIRSCH or DERSOWIN, and these names are also not known to UPHILL. It is requested that headquarters attempt to determine the nature of Subjects' contact with UPHILL.
