FOR YOUR INFORMATION

1. During a routine CART-type interrogation on 30 March 1966 Subject made the following statement which may be of interest to AIS:

CLEMENS admitted that he passed the KGB all information on WOFACT-CATUSK courier flights from Frankfurt to Berlin as it was known to him. Specifically, he passed the name and description of a Sergeant (since forgotten) who processed all personnel on such flights during 1953/55. The only thing he now recalls was that the Sergeant was very heavy and arrogant.

2. CATUSK has no further information.
