1. SAID DURING A DISCUSSION OF THE SINO-INDIAN BORDER SITUATION THAT THE CHINESE WOULD AGREE TO THE MCMAHON LINE, BUT THAT IT HAS YET TO BE DECIDED WHERE THE LINE IS LOCATED. THE SINO-INDIAN BORDER HAS NEVER BEEN DELINEATED AND THE CHINESE COMMUNIST GOVERNMENT HAS NEVER RECOGNIZED ANY BORDER AGREEMENT.

CHINA WANTED TO SETTLE THE BORDER DISPUTE PEACEFULLY BUT IT WAS ATTACKED BY INDIA AND NOW HAD TO PROTECT ITSELF.
