- Fru Girdzijauskas, a junior instructor, taught bacteriology. He was about il years old, a graduate of the University of Kaumas, quite tall. 10. about 6 ft in height, weighed about 190 pounds, nice looking, a swarthy complexion, full of energy and was very talkative.
- Before the Germans occupied Kaunas the doctor went to the USSR and a few years later returned to Kaunas where he became a supervisor and issued directives in the field of medical research.
- Dr. Lasas, taught physiology. Until the German occupation he was dean of medicine but was replaced by Dr /fnu/Meskaukas. Lasas was between 55 58, he was educated in Russia during the Czar's reign, he was 12. heavy set, wore glasses, bald, and had a reddish complexion. He was about 5 ft 8 in in height, weighed about 200 pounds and he was a Communist sympathizer.
- Dr Lasas was doing research work in endocrinology as of 1949. His wife, is also an MD. She is tall, heavy set, and a Socialist radical. She is the author of a book on the pituitary glands.
