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(U) The fastest male runner was  and the fastest female runner was  After the race, participants refreshed with water and Halloween candy.

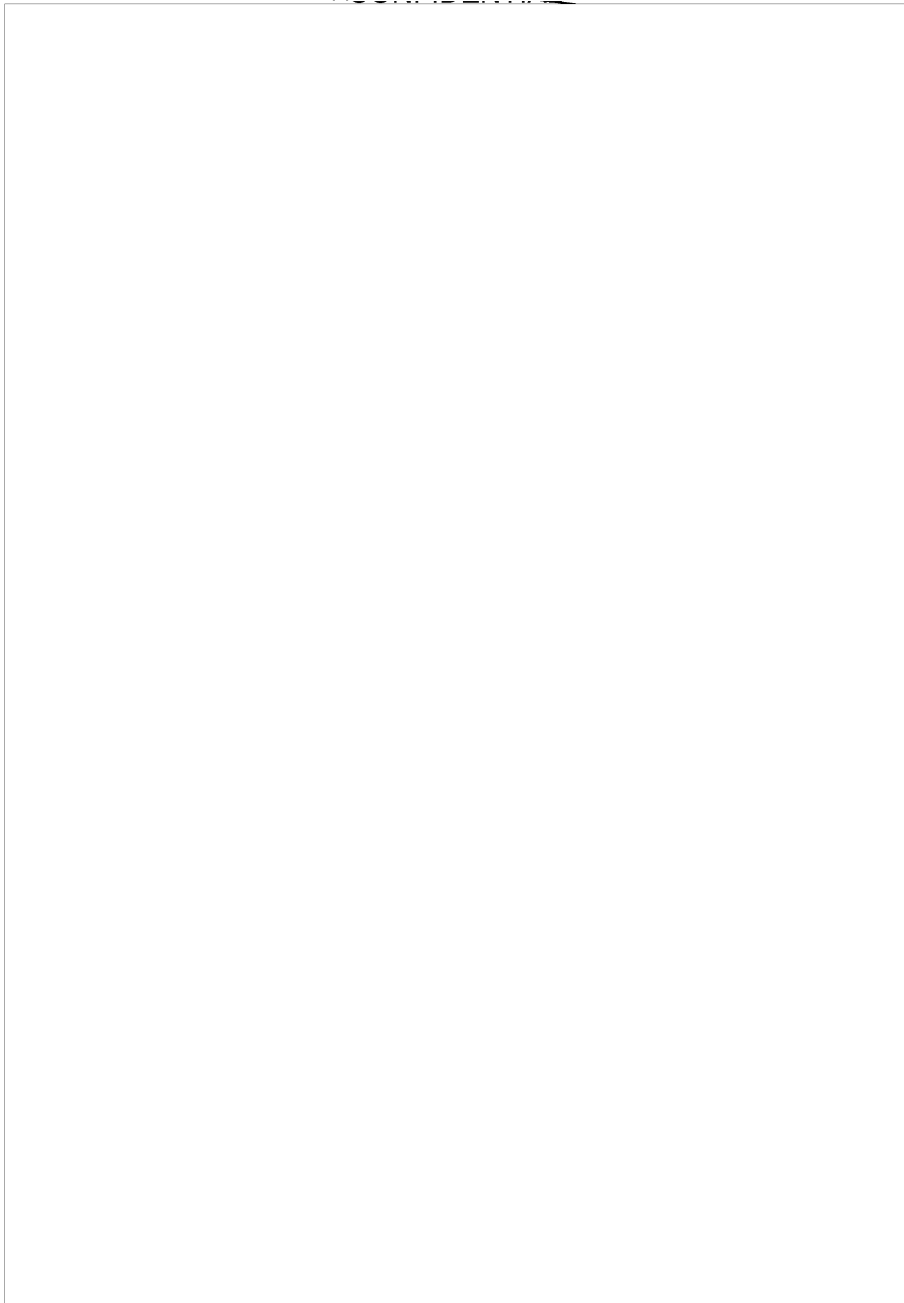
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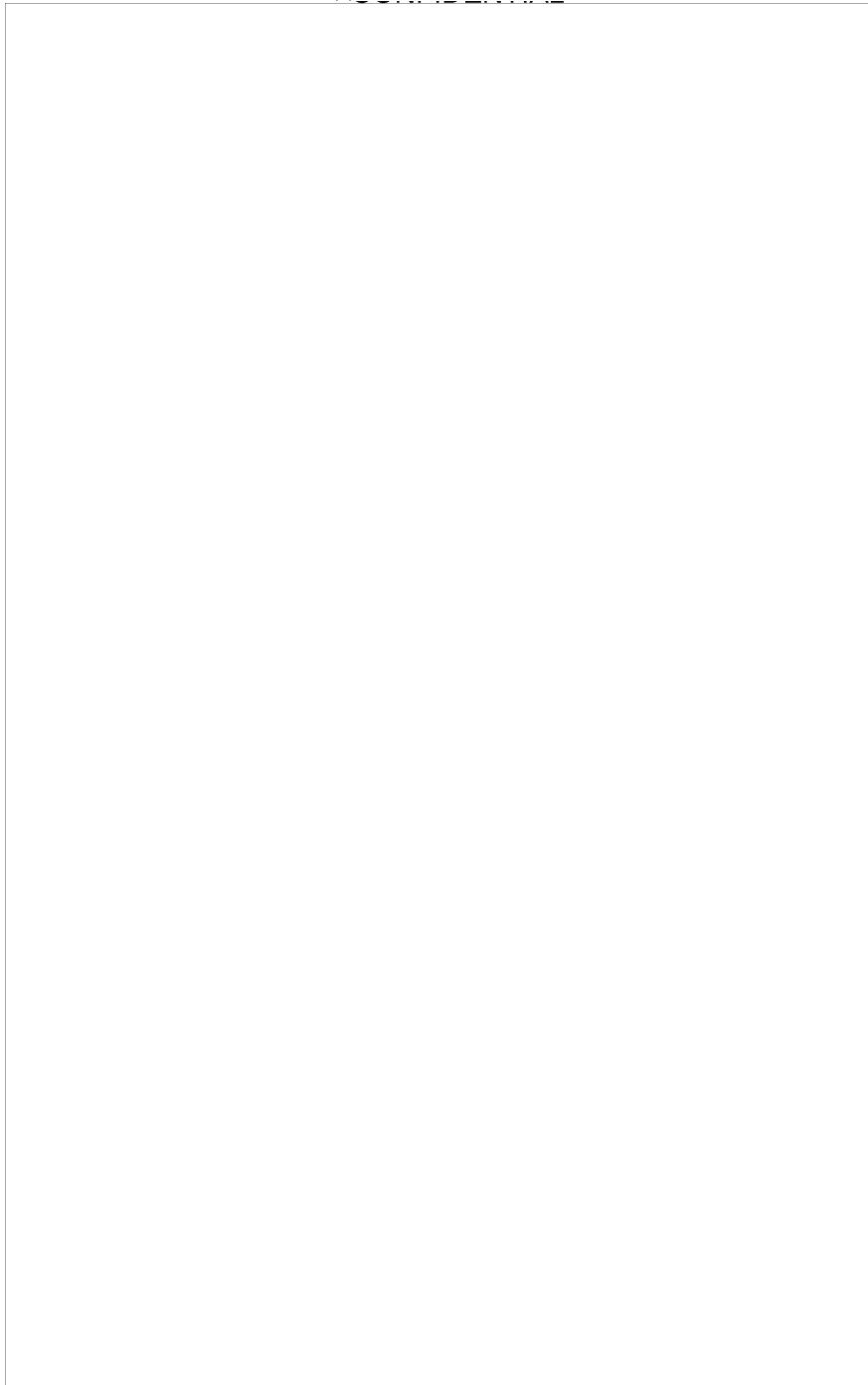
