[redacted] was contacted on 26 November 1973 by an unidentified man, believed to be Cuban, who inquired into [redacted] departure. She stated she was scheduled to leave for Cuba on 3 December but preferred to wait until 10 December. The man, who was addressed only as [redacted], stated that the 10 December departure could be arranged. He also stated that one [redacted] Last Name Unknown (LNU) and [redacted] LNU had asked him to contact [redacted] [redacted] had arrived in Mexico on 16 November 1973 and was staying at the residence of Cuban Embassy personnel.)

[Redacted] contacted the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City on 20 December 1973 to ask if the visas were ready for the group, including [Redacted] and [Redacted] who were traveling to Cuba on 20 December 1973. [Redacted] also advised the Cuban Embassy that he had a letter for Manuel CORTINA Castro from the Venceremos Brigade. CORTINA is the Third Secretary of the Cuban Embassy and a known intelligence officer.)

j. Arrived in Madrid, Spain from Havana via Cubana Airlines on 25 December 1973:

2. A sensitive source also reported that Julian TORRES Rizo, a Cuban intelligence officer responsible for the Venceremos Brigade and the Instituto de Investigaciones de Mexico Y Aztlan, arrived in Mexico City on 11 December 1973 from New York City and proceeded to Havana on 14 December 1973.
