- During the week of 10-15 June we noticed a definite drup in the number of Cuben children departing from Cube for the US. During this week, we noticed the highest drop in uncocompanied children traveling to the US from Cube during the past nine months.
- 2. In the past we had been averaging 200 children per week which continued until about three weeks ago. Since then we have been receiving some 60-70 children per week. During the week, 10-16 June, 77 children came but all arrived in the first two days of the week. Since Vednesday, 13 June, we received cally 1-2 children per day.
- 3. We have not received any information from Cuba as to why this outlon drop in the number of unprompensed skildren. There is a possibility that Castro is now extending an order that unprompensed skildren would not be promitted to travel to the US.
