Comment: The French, British and Soviet representatives last month demanded an additional 400 thousand to 800 thousand dollars over the US-proposed ceiling of 4.4 million dollars per occupying power for Austrian occupation costs. Austria already faces a 1952 budget deficit of over 31 million dollars.

8.	American Embassy in Paris comments on Schuman Plan ratification:
	The US Embassy in Paris views the French Assembly's ratification of the Schuman Plan by a large majority as evidence that the deputies now consider it politically risky to oppose the growing public sentiment for European unification. The government's triumph, however, does not mean that the coalition is now much more cohesive, inasmuch as its cleavages are economic and ideological and "have nothing to do with foreign policy."
9.	Comment: The growing force of French public opinion favoring European unity is indicated by the failure of the steel interests, despite their major effort against the treaty, to influence more than a few conservative deputies.
ð.	The Spanish Minister of Commerce has in-3.3(h)(2) formed the American Ambassador in Madrid that Spanish dollar obligations for the next six months exceed cash dollar assets by more than seven million. The Ambassador urges immediate and special efforts on the part of the Export-Import Bank to conclude commodity credits to Spain which would ease the strain. He believes that, after a year's publicity of forthcoming US aid and on the eve of possible military negotiations, should a publicly-known financial crisis develop the US position in Spain would be prejudiced.

Comment: The Spanish Government has consistently ignored the repeated requests of the United States Government for information concerning Spain's balance-of-payments and dollar position, and, in pressing the Embassy for a short-term cotton loan in September, the Spanish Minister of Commerce gave no indication of a serious dollar shortage.
