Although the number and types of aircraft at these two fields are not known, the presence of planes in this area has raised the threat of Communist air action against the Chinese Nationalists and indicates a bolstering of Communist air defense of the southeast China coastal regions.

Comment: The French have long feared that Hainan may be used as a base for air attacks on Tonkin. The Chinese Communists, however, are believed to be primarily concerned over the island's defense because of rumors in the past year of a planned assault on the island by American and Chinese Nationalist forces, and the Soviet specialists may have visited Hainan in this connection.
