MEMORANDUM FOR: THE COMMISSIONER
IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION SERVICE

SUBJECT: Caselaw GRZELAK

1. This refers to your memorandum dated January 11, 1949, bearing file number A-5722976, and concerning deportation proceedings against Caselaw GRZELAK.

2. In referring to the last sentence of paragraph one, please note that the Polish Communist Party (named Polish United Workers Party since December 15, 1948) is the same as the Communist Party of any other country insofar as it has the same objectives, is subject to the same discipline and control, and receives instructions from the same source. The scope of our activities is such that we are not in a position to supply documents or other material which would be legally admissible as evidence to substantiate the fact that the Polish Communist Party advocates the forcible overthrow of the United States Government. You may desire to refer to the appropriate division of the Department of Justice for such documentary evidence or for names of refugees in the United States who may qualify as expert witnesses.
