PROPOSED DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE DIRECTIVE 1/4 INTELLIGENCE FOR THE RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT BOARD

Under the authority of paragraph 3 of National Security Council Intelligence Directive 1, the Central Intelligence Agency shall:

- 1. Coordinate the collection of all intelligence information related to foreign scientific research developments and potentialities affecting the national security.
- 2. Accomplish the correlation, evaluation, and appropriate dissemination within the Government of the resulting intelligence.
- 3. Supervise and control the flow of intelligence material between the Research and Development Board and the departments and other agencies of the Government.
