LINC WILL NOTIFY HQS DEXERNAL AS FAR IN ADVANCE AS PRACTICABLE OF FINAL TIMING AND KEEP HQS INFORMED OF SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENTS THEREAFTER, BUT THIS REQUIREMENT DOES NOT IMPLY ANY NEED FOR FURTHER HQS APPROVAL FOR LAUNCHING OPERATION.
- 3. ACCORDINGLY IT BECOMES A MATTER OF LINC'S JUDGMENT AS TO WHAT WILL CONSTITUTE ADEQUATE STATE OF READINESS AND WHETHER THIS HAS BEEN ACHIEVED, AS WELL AS DRAW THE FINAL CONCLUSIONS AS TO POSITION OF WSBURNT

- 4. CONCERNING PARA 3 OF REF A. IT IS OUR CURRENT REVISED VIEW THAT IN EVENT CALLICERIS SHOULD FAIL FOR ANY REASON TO COMMIT HIS PRESENT EXTERNAL REPEAT EXTERNAL FORCES, THESE IN THEIR PRESENT ORGANIZATIONAL FORM WOULD BE OF LITTLE USE IN A LONGER PULL EFFORT OF A RESISTANCE NATURE AND ON CONTRARY WOULD CONSTITUTE SECURITY LIABILITY TO PBPRIME FROM BOTH OPERATIONAL AND POLITICAL STANDPOINTS. CALLIGERIS AND HIS PRINCIPAL CONFEDERATES ARE TOO FAR BLOWN AND WOULD BE TOO COMPROMISED AND DISCREDITED IN EVENT FAILURE THEIR ATTEMPT WITHIN VERY NEAR FUTURE. IT MIGHT BE POSSIBLE UNDER NEW LEADERSHIP TO MAKE SOME USE OF INTERNAL ASSETS IN CONNECTION WITH DRASTICALLY REVISED PROGRAM.
- 5. THIS MESSAGE DOES NOT REPEAT NOT AUTHORIZE TYPES OF ACTION PREVIOUSLY REJECTED ON POLICY GROUNDS SUCH AS AIR TO GROUND ACTION, ETC.
- 6. FOREGOING DRAFTED PRIOR RECEIPT REF C WHICH INDICATES SUBSTANTIAL SIMILARITY OUR THINKING ON POINTS INVOLVED.
