2. GARCIA REACHED THIS DECISION DURING PRIVATE CONSULTATIONS
ON THE EVENING OF 30 DECEMBER 1982 WITH PRESIDENT ALVARO ((MAGANA)
AND COLONEL RAFAEL ((FLORES)) LIMA, CHIEF OF STAFF, WHO AGREE
THAT THE TRANSFER OF OCHOA, GARCIA' MOST OUTSPOKEN CRITIC
IN THE ARMY, WAS NECESSARY TO CONTROL THE GROWING OPPOSITION
TO GARCIA IN THE MILITARY ESTABLISHMENT. ALTHOUGH IT IS EXPECTED
THAT THE ORDER TO TRANSFER OCHOA WILL BE RESISTED BY OCHOA
AND OTHER LIKE-MINDED ARMY OFFICERS, GARCIA AND FLORES LIMA
BELIEVE THEY HAVE SUFFICIENT SUPPORT TO HANDLE ANY ADVERSE
REACTION. THE PLAN TO REMOVE
OCHOA, WHO IS POPULAR AMONG THE JUNIOR OFFICERS AND ENJOYS
A REPUTATION AS ONE OF THE ARMY'S BEST FIELD COMMANDERS, COULD
PROVOKE A CONFRONTATION BETWEEN GARCIA AND THE RIGHTIST
POLITICAL SECTOR AS WELL AS ELEMENTS IN THE ARMY.
IT LIKELY THAT THE TRANSFER OF OCHOA WILL BE CHALLENGED BY
ROBERTO ((D'AUBUISSON)), PRESIDENT OF THE CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY
AND LEADER OF THE NATIONALIST REPUBLICAN ALLIANCE (ARENA),
WITH WHOM OCHOA IS CLOSELY ALLIED AND WHO STRONGLY FAVORS
THE REMOVAL OF GARCIA.

3. EARLIER ON 30 DECEMBER, FLORES LIMA HAD MET PRIVATELY WITH JOSE DOMINGO ((MONTERROSA)), COMMANDER OF THE ATLACATL BATTALION, IN A CONTINUING EFFORT TO LINE UP SUPPORT FOR GARCIA AMONG KEY COMMANDERS TO COUNTER THE PLANS OF RIGHTIST CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY MEMBERS TO EFFECT GARCIA'S REMOVAL. WHILE MONTERROSA INDICATED THAT HE DID NOT OBJECT TO GARCIA REMAINING IN OFFICE, HE FIRMLY REFUSED FLORES LIMA'S REQUEST TO PARTICIPATE IN A VOTE OF CONFIDENCE FOR GARCIA, EITHER PRIVATELY OR PUBLICLY. MONTERROSA SAID THAT FLORES LIMA COULD EXPECT THE SAME RESPONSE TOWARDS GARCIA FROM THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS: OCHOA PEREZ, LTC. NAPOLEON HERSON ((CALITTO)), COMMANDER OF THE ATONAL BATTALION; LTC. MIGUEL ALFREDO ((VASCONCELOS)), COMMANDER OF USULUTAN DEPARTMENT; LTC. MIGUEL ANTONIO ((MENDE)) COMMANDER OF THE RAMON BELLOSO BATTALION; LTC. OSCAR RODOLFO ((CAMPOS)) AMAYA, COMMANDER OF THE CAVALRY REGIMENT; LTC. RICARDO ((CIENFUEGOS)), PERSONAL AIDE TO FLORES LIMA; LTC. JULIO CESAR ((LOPEZ)) YANES, SUBDIRECTOR OF THE NATIONAL POLICE; LTC. ARMANDO ((RIVERA)); COMMANDER OF CUSCATLAN DEPARTMENT AND LTC. OSCAR ARMANDO ((AMAYA)) PEREZ, COMMANDER OF LA LIBERTAD DEPARTMENT.
