The gist of the presentation was that we would retain the [Redacted] as our principal headquarters but would attempt to make arrangements to have other parts of the Agency located at [Redacted]. After some consideration we decided to [Redacted] White Sulphur Springs where the Congress will be located. We felt that the county could not absorb both and that it would be better for us to locate elsewhere; otherwise General Cabell approved.
