Itinerary for South American Trip

1. Travel arrangements for CARAVEL's South American trip are now being completed. His tentative schedule is as follows: Depart Frankfurt on 16 September for Rio de Janeiro, Brasilia, Sao Paulo. He will divide roughly three days between these three cities. He then goes to Buenos Aires for two days; Santiago, Chile for three days; Asuncion, Paraguay where he will spend half day; then Lima, Peru for two days; Ecuador one day; Bogota, Columbia for one day. He arrives at Caracas, Venezuela on 27 September for annual INTERPOL meeting which lasts to 3 October. He will go to Mexico City for three or four days by way of Panama and then expects to spend a day or two in San Francisco and return to Germany via Montreal on Lufthansa. He expects to be back in Germany on 15 October.

2. In all of the cities mentioned, he will meet with police officials whom he knows, who were trained here in Germany or with whom a relationship has been maintained. The exception is Paraguay where he will have a short conference with the German Ambassador in connection with the wanted wartime criminal, Dr. Joseph MENGELE who is one of the doctors responsible for the selection of the victims for execution in Auschwitz.

3. CARAVEL expressed one personal wish, namely, some assistance in San Francisco. He would like to do some sightseeing and if it were possible, to have someone meet him with an automobile and show him the sights of the city to give him the maximum benefit of a short (probably not more than 36 hours) stay between planes. He has no business of any kind in San Francisco. We advised him that we would make a request accordingly. We believe that such a gesture to CARAVEL is in order and request that preliminary arrangements be made for it. We will provide precise contact arrangements prior to his departure.
