SUBJECT: Visit of an Official of the West German Criminal
 Police to the United States

TOP SECRET

1. For your information, Paul DICKOPF, the Deputy Chief of the West German Criminal Police (Bundeskriminalamt), will visit the United States in mid October. Mr. DICKOPF intends to visit San Francisco, California, at the conclusion of a South American trip, the purpose of which will be to attend the annual INTERPOL meeting in Caracas, Venezuela, on 27 September 1964. His itinerary includes visits to the following cities: Rio de Janeiro, Brazilia, Sao Paulo, Brazil; Buenos Aires, Argentina; Santiago, Chile; Asuncion, Paraguay; Lima, Peru; Ecuador; Bogota, Columbia; Caracas, Venezuela; Mexico City, Mexico; Panama; San Francisco, California; and Montreal, Canada. He will be en route from 16 September to 15 October and will probably arrive in San Francisco about 12 October for an approximate 36 hour stop-over.

2. A representative of this Agency will meet Mr. DICKOPF with an automobile in order to assist him in arranging accommodations and to show him the sights of the city. This is to be purely a sightseeing visit; Mr. DICKOPF has no business of any kind in San Francisco.
