- 1. During the meeting described in reference memorandum it had been agreed that and landscer 10 would meet again in Innsbruck in early August 1951. On 1 August wrote to Landscer 10's mother, suggested a meeting in Innsbruck on 9 August, and asked Landscer 10 to write a pre-arranged Salgburg letterbox, in the event he should be unable to travel to Innsbruck. Meen no letter from Landscer 10 had arrived by 8 August, and a few days later he wrote a letter to the Salzburg letterbox explaining that official business had prevented him at the last minute from keeping the Innsbruck appointment.
- 3. On 27 August [ ] introduced [ ] to Landseer 10 as [ ] of G-2, USFA. Landseer 10 invited [ ] and [ ] to his new spartment in Bregens-Vorkloster, Feldweg, faegernorsiedlung. Landseer 10 explained that he had obtained the apartment, located in a newly constructed building, through the intervention of the Security Director to whom he had complained about his unsatisfactory quarters in Wolfurt.

- 6. Landseer 10 laced L I and L I his file on German officers serving in Syria, which Landseer 10 had obtained from the mother of an Austrian who had served in Syria and who was killed in an automobile accident in Germany in late 1950. The file which contains a lot of incoherent correspondence, documents, etc. is being sifted by L I and excerpts will be forwarded to Headquarters shortly.
- 7. Landseer 10 stated that he had reported to Greengroeer 1 that Belies Inspector Maximilian MATTES, (a former informant of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ at present stationed in Klagenfurt, is serving as an agent or the Israeli IS under Simon WIESENTHAL. As reported in para 3, c, of reference memorandum, Jan GAJENSKI and HATTES had wittingly deceived Landseer 10 by introducing WIESENTHAL to him as "Mr. SIMON of CIC." Landseer 10 hopes that his report to Green-Grocer 1 will result in a formal investigation of MATTES getivities.

8. In a previous meeting Landseer 10 had mentioned the BEGUS case and he now reports that BEGUS was used by the FIS to penetrate the Swiss IS and had established contact with Major HAUSAMAN. Through his Swiss police contact Emil RUFTHEMANN, reported in para 3,d, of reference memorandum, Landseer 10 obtained a copy of a report massed by BEGUS to HAUSAMANN in late 1950 and showed it to \_\_\_\_\_ The so-called report, signed "Otto", was violently anti-American in tone and dwelled in great length on alleged American recruitment of Austrian nationals for military service in Kerea,
