2. Meanwhile, only the medical program is permitted to be carried out. Dr. Leo Eloesser, head of the North China UNICEF, is making no headway with his over-all program, and the only alternative is to cease functioning completely. Dr. Eloesser is planning a trip to Tsinan for a month. (b)(1) (b)(3)
