- SALAAM OF FLYERS ATTACKING THE FRELIMO LEADERSHIP (AND MONDLANE IN PARTICULAR) AUTHORIZED AND SIGNED BY FATHER MATEUS GWENJERE.

 MONDLANE NOTED THAT FRELIMO IS PROHIBITED BY THE TANZANIAN

 GOVERNMENT FROM ENGAGING IN ANY TYPE OF POLITICAL ACTIVITY WITHIN TANZANIA. IN THE SPIRIT OF THIS INSTRUCTION MONDLANE BELIEVED THAT THE DISTRIBUTION OF GWENJERE'S PAMPHLETS SHOULD ALSO BE PROHIBITED BY THE TANZANIANS. MINISTER OF STATE SIJAONA OBSERVED THAT NOBODY TOOK THESE PAMPHLETS SERIOUSLY; THEREFORE MONDLANE SHOULD NOT WORRY ABOUT THEM. MONDLANE DISAGREED, STATING THAT THESE PAMPHLETS HAD A WIDE DISTRIBUTION AND REACHED FOREIGN EMBASSIES. THIS COULD SERIOUSLY AFFECT FRELIMO'S STANDING WITH A NUMBER OF FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS FRIENDLY TO FRELIMO. VICE-PRESIDENT KAWAWA AGREED AND STATED THAT IMMEDIATE STEPS WOULD BE TAKEN TO STOP THE PAMPHLETERING.

ITS REPORT ON 29 OR 30 AFR IL, AND HE HAD BEEN INFORMED THAT ONE OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS WOULD BE THAT HE AND GWENJERE SHOULD MEET TO DISCUSS THEIR DIFFERENCES, AFTER WHICH THE ALC WITH THE TANZANIAN GOVERNMENT WOULD TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION CONCERNING GWENJERE, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE FRELIMO LEADERSHIP. MONDLANE NOTED THAT HE HAD NEVER EXPELLED ANYONE FROM FRELIMO.

- INSTITUTE. MONDLANE POINTED OUT THAT ALL STUDENTS HAD BEEN RETURNED TO THE SCHOOL WITH THE EXCEPTION OF 15 WHO HAD GONE TO NAIROBI TO LOOK FOR OTHER SCHOOLING AT THE SUGGESTION OF GWENJERE. MONDLANE EMPHASIZED THAT FRELIMO COULD NOT AFFORD TO HAVE THE SCHOOL CLOSED ANY LONGER, WITH THE STUDENTS IDLE. HE SUGGESTED THAT SIJAONA HIMSELF FORMALLY RE-OPEN THE SCHOOL, AS SIJAONA HAD BEEN THE ONE WHO CLOSED IT. VICE-PRESIDENT KAWAWA AGREED, AND SAID THAT THE SCHOOL WOULD DEFINITELY BE RE-OPENED THE WEEK OF 28 AFRIL.
- 6. AT THE END OF THIS MEETING VICE-PRESIDENT KAWAWA ASSURED MONDLANE THAT THE TANZANIAN GOVERNMENT FULLY SUPPORTED THE FRELIMO LEADERSHIP WITHOUT QUALIFICATION.
