APPROXIMATELY 100 PROPAGANDA LEAFLETS WERE DISTRIBUTED AT THE OLYMPIC MARKET. THEY WERE THROWN IN A BUNDLE FROM A MILITARY JEEP CARRYING TWO MEN IN CIVILIAN CLOTHES. THE TRACTS WERE ANTI-GOVERNMENT, ANTI-VIETNAMESE, AND ANTI-AMERICAN IN THEME, AND THEY ENJOINED ALL SEGMENTS OF THE POPULATION TO RISE UP AND "EXPEL ALL FOREIGN ELEMENTS FROM CAMBODIA".
