109. Jackpot. Sent my 3423-31 after mature consideration but realized you might feel that I was disposed to listen to fairy stories. For over year I have observed 512 both directly and through series of other agents and have checked on his past history. I believe he would not knowingly deceive me. He has relatively low regard for political courage of German Generals view previous disappointments in dealings with them in matters similar to those discussed my main message. He frankly says that if we are confident of quick success and early occupation Germany through invasion he would be disposed to advise us to have nothing to do with German Generals. In any event I thought you should have for your appraisal picture presented my main message. I fully realize delicacy of matter and proceeding with utmost caution. Zeta is Zeitzler, Eta is General Olbrecht reported to be Chief of German Army administration. Theta is General Heusinger Chief of operations for Zeta and Ladder is Halder.
