

On 12 October 1964, Mary P. Meyer was shot to death on the towpath along the C and O Canal in Georgetown at 1245 hours. Friends stated she had walked there often, sometimes in the company of Mrs. Jacquelyn Kennedy. She was described as a prominent Georgetown artist and a sister of Mrs. Benjamin Bradlee, now Executive Editor, <u>Washington Post</u>. She was also described as a close friend of former President John F. Kennedy. The slaying was witnessed by a man who said he saw her struggle with a man. Police were called and shortly thereafter, a laborer was arrested in the vicinity and charged with the slaying. The suspect was subsequently acquitted in the trial and the murder remains unsolved. Mr. Cord Meyer remarried in 1965.
