Excerpt of pertinent information :

(d) The Bulgarian Anti-Bolshevik Union (BAU) which is divided into several sub-groups, is headed by Ivan DOTSHEFF, who was born 7 January 1906 in Schumen, Bulgaria. Politically active in his youth, he was interned in 1937 for his efforts with the Bulgarian National Legion, a group he founded while studying law at the University of Sofia. From 1941 to 1943 he was Mayor of Dborojan, Silistra, Bulgaria, and later Secretary -General of the Bulgarian Farmer's Union. His employment in 1944 by the Bulgarian exile Government forced him to keep a few steps ahead of the authorities from late 1944 to 1946 when he gathered friends around him to form an anti-communist group. For his efforts against the present Bulgarian regime, Dotsheff has been tried and sentenced in absentia by a Bulgarian People's Court.
