Emigration of Dr. Iwan DOTSCHEV

1. According to the procedure agreed upon by [] and [] at a conference in March (see MGL-A-1764), we originally forwarded subject's case to you because we felt it warranted and required your attention. On receipt of reference we checked with Major Milano hoping to find a solution somewhat less involved than that outlined in para 2 of reference. He informed us that he could have been of assistance had subject addressed his appeal to the DP Commission, Salzburg rather than the DP Commission, Frankfurt. He also stated that since the DP Commission, Frankfurt does in fact have authority over the DP Commission, Salzburg, our intervention at Frankfurt would be entirely in order.

2. We then attempted to contact [] but since he was not available, we discussed the case with []. [] stated that they had had similar cases in the past which were solved by []'s intervention in Frankfurt. [] took down the pertinent data and kindly offered to be of help by putting [] on the case.

3. In the meantime, we were informed that subject must report to the DP Commission, Salzburg for screening for emigration to Australia since his US emigration has been disapproved. If he fails to do so before 31 May 1950, he loses his DP status. We have requested Milano to intervene to prevent such decisive action by the DP Commission, pending the results of our intervention in Frankfurt.

4. The problem has been further complicated by an automobile accident which left [] temporarily indisposed. [] suggested that we return subject's case to you (see attachment) and we now request that you take steps to intervene in Frankfurt. i.e. the buck is passed again.
