SUBJECT: Emigration to USA (DOTSCHEFF)
REF : 27.2 No. 1122, 12 July 1950

From a conference with General Agency C and from available records the following was learned on the activities of Subject (Dr. Iwan DOTSCHEFF @ Ivan DIMITROFF) for our organization:

1. From the beginning of 1946 to the end of the year he worked for CIC SALZBURG. Each month he reported on the activities of the Bulgarian Communists in Austria. From the beginning of 1947 to mid-1948, he worked for CIC BAD REICHENHALL and then for CIC MUNICH. He reported on the activities of Bulgarian Communists in Germany and Austria. Mr. KOCH (CIC SALZBURG) and Mr. PETROVICH (CIC MUNICH) are in the position to furnish details.

In summer 1947, DOTSCHEFF came into contact with the former coworker PESCHKE (former Sub-org 178) and worked with 178 until mid-1948. General Agency C is in contact with Subject since April 1948.

2. In detail, Subject supplied our organization with the following information:

- a. every two weeks a report on the economic situation in Bulgaria,
- b. monthly reports on the political situation in Bulgaria,
- c. he submitted charts containing important military objects. (of the army and the airforce),
- d. 2 or 3 reports on the military situation in Bulgaria,
- e. copies of the Bulgarian laws concerning economic questions and copies or information on economic contracts of the SU with the Satellites,
- f. constant delivery of official Communist publications in Bulgaria.

g. reports on important broadcasts of radio
SOFIA!

GV C missioned Subject to contact persons
qualified for commitment into Bulgaria. Project 79
is based on subject.

In addition, Subject supplied our org. with
numerous interrogation reports on political, economic
and military questions. He interrogated Bulgarian
military personnel who fled from Bulgaria and forwarded
reports on the Bulgarian Army and Airforce. A portion
of his information is contained in MGI reports.

His good connections to Bulgarian emigrants
were valuable for his activities for our org.

3. During his employment by GV C DOTSCHKEFF
received the following payments:

From 1 April 1949 to 30 July 1950,

	1,200.- Austrian Shillings per month
in August 1950	1,000.- Austrian Shillings
for September 1950	500.- Austrian Shillings.

From May 1948 to April 1949, only his expenses and office
costs were repaid. In October, Subject had to pay
hospital bill (jaw operation) and was given 1,250.-
Austrian Shillings which are to be considered his
termination pay. No other termination pay is intended.

4. DOTSCHKEFF was a very diligent coworker and
accomplished his missions satisfactorily. Most of his
reports were good. It is, therefore, again requested

a. to intervene with DP Commission SALZBURG
to prevent that he loses the possibility to emigrate to
the USA; the last day for intervention is 1 Oct 50.
(see Memo 32B No. 381, 16 August 1950).

b. to intervene with IRO FRANKFURT to
support Subject's appeal against the prohibition to
emigrate.
