1. Attached is a somewhat more detailed statement of subject's ZIPPER activities. The charges made in WASHF-5912, particularly those pertaining to his ineptness, are essentially true although some of your comments can be attributed to the lack of honest and comprehensive project reporting by CV "C" and ZIPPER headquarters. This, coupled with the generally low level of Bulgarian operations caused us to instruct inform ZIPPER that we were not willing to further assist subject in his emigration to the U.S. We suggested that he accept emigration to another country, probably Australia.

2. While project 79 has been terminated there are still many loose ends to be tied up. I will pursue the investigation of the CI aspects (the possibility that 11 842 and 11 843 were doubled, the BERBEROFF angle etc.) and his findings will be duly forwarded.
