After Germany's capitulation, all cabinet members of TSANKOV's government...were interned by the American and British authorities in their respective zones of Germany and Austria...

STATEV, TSANKOV DOSHEV, ...are still strong nationalists like all other members of the ex-Vienna Government. It is a travesty of justice that these men denounce to the Italian authorities, and probably to other authorities, the truly patriotic activities of the Bulgarian pro-National Committee and its members as <sup>pro-</sup>communist. The so-called Bulgarian committees are nothing else but branches of TSANKOV's former Vienna Government. These committees are...

The Revival Circle in Paris...The political and ideological program of the Revival Circle truly reflects the views of TSANKOV, STATEV, DOSHEV and other members of the former Vienna Cabinet...

The National and anti-Communist Circle set up by Ivan DOSHEV in Munich in 1949 is made up exclusively of former legionnaires of the pro-Nazi Vienna Cabinet...DOSHEV made an offer of collaboration to G.M. DIMITROV in 1947-48, but received no reply. He then offered his service to Colonel Stoyan ZAIMOV, Bulgarian Military Attache in Rome and Chief of Bulgaria's espionage services in Western Europe. (In this connection ZAIMOV dispatched in May, 1948, his secret agent Nicolai TOSHKOV to meet Ivan DOSHEV in Munich)..."
