1. On 10 April 1951 Boshko/Boschkov of the Lavrion Refugee Camp replied to a letter from Ivan Dochev Post Box 164, Salzburg, Austria. In the letter Boshkov covered the following subjects:
- a. He explained the differences between himself and (Colonel) Ivan Golomanov, with whom, he believes, there can be no understanding and collaboration.
  - b. From refugees who have recently arrived in Greece, he has learned that they have five members(sic), who are sufficiently well organized in the areas of Khaskovo, Stara Zagora, Plovdiv, and Smolen. Those five have the aid of "our" combatants. Roycho/Roev is the director of the liberation campaign. He does not know the exact number of partisans, but he knows the objectives in the mines of Dimitrograd and Kurdshali, and the movements in the area of Plovdiv. But, in order to write on all this, he would like to secure mailing expenses.
  - c. He assures Dochev again as to his nationalist convictions, and he feels sorry if his respect towards Dochev depends on his relations with Golomanov.
  - d. He eases Dochev's fear about the Greek censors, and assures him that the Greeks know that both of them are anti-Communists.
