SUBJECT: DOCHEV, Ivan

1. This afternoon, I contacted [] of Cover Division with regard to his laying on the cover of a company from which the letter would go to Subject inviting him to come to New York to discuss the pending "business deal".
2. It so happened that [] was leaving tonight for New York, and he thought that he might be able to handle this assignment while on this trip; at least, he felt that it might be possible, although he had nothing concrete in mind.
3. To this end, I gave him Subject's name, and the fact that he lived in Toronto, Canada, stating that I would have to get ~~xx~~ Subject's street address from the file the next day. We agreed that if [] should be able to lay this on while in New York tomorrow, he would phone me at my office and that I would give him the street address only over the phone. He would then be in a position to ~~write~~ have the matter all ready to go when I gave the word.
4. It will then be necessary for me to phone [] and tell him all is well, and that he is to tell Subject to expect a letter from this firm.
