1. On Tuesday, 9 March 1954 at 1700, I phoned Subject at his home in Wellesley, Mass., to confirm two points also covered in a letter posted the same evening.

2. The two points are as follows:

A. Re DOCHEV: that we would not, as I had said in my letter of 5 March, arrange for a firm in the U.S. to send him a letter inviting him to come to the U.S. I indicated that this would involve too many complications and that he was not to mention this to DOCHEV at all. I told him that he was to tell DOCHEV that he was to make his own arrangements about coming to the U.S.

B. I indicated to him (as per our discussion when he was here last week) that he would be in N.Y. on 4 April to begin his training there, and that I would see him there on that date. (This was also covered in a separate letter also mailed the evening of 9 March.)
