SUBJECT: Request for Assistance in Transmitting Operational Funds to Ivan DOGHEV

REFERENCE: Conference between C and C 1 SE-2, 10 August 1954

1. Project BOCORVOY, approved 6 August 1954, authorizes expenditures for the development and exploitation of Ivan DOGHEV, leader of the Bulgarian National Front. Dr. DOGHEV is presently residing in Canada (P.O. Box 163, Adelaide Street P.O., Toronto, Canada).

2. On 6 August 1954 GPF/P&O approved the payment of \$500 to Dr. DOGHEV to assist in the payment of expenses in connection with a 9 September 1954 issue of "Haroden Glas", organ of the Bulgarian National Front. It is essential that Dr. DOGHEV receive these funds as near 15 August 1954 as possible.

3. In order to conceal the source of the funds, we request your assistance in procuring and mailing two money orders payable to Dr. Ivan DOGHEV, P.O. Box 163, Adelaide Street P.O., Toronto, Canada in the following manner:

a) One in the amount of \$175, to be purchased in Chicago in the name of Georgi PAPRIKOV, 630 South Hermitage Avenue, Chicago 12, Illinois

b) One in the amount of \$325, to be purchased in New York City in the name of Kalin KOICHEV, 107 Romein Place, Leonia, New Jersey.

This method of transmitting funds was discussed by C on 6 August with DDP/Y&R (Mr. Winston M. Scott) and approved by him.

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4. Operational Clearance No. C-26466 (file No. 94993) for contact and assessment of operational potentialities of Ivan DOGHEV was issued on 11 May 1944. The first operational contact has been made. Information obtained therefrom, indicates the advisability of continuance of developmental contacts and the above financial support.

5. Georgi PAPRIKOV and Kalin KOICHEV are trusted followers of DOGHEV. However, they are completely unwitting of our negotiations with DOGHEV and the use of their names as indicated above. Operational Clearances have therefore not been requested.

6. We shall appreciate your advising us as soon as possible whether the purchase can be made by you so that Dr. DOGHEV can be advised to expect the money. We request that the money orders be purchased and mailed to Dr. DOGHEV from the city in which purchased and that receipts for same be returned to ☐ Room 1407 J. The amount is to be charged to BGOONVOY (Account No. 5-3220-51-043).
