I am sure that you will find it difficult to find among Bulgarians another who would better fill the bill (Lit: who would better solve a problem). But...we shall let the future show.

I have not ceased to be interested in and to work for the realization of my projects. I now have concrete declarations from the people ~~in~~ in Wales, Australia, and Trieste, Italy. And I am continuing. We shall not refuse to conduct our opposition and liberation struggle. It was possible to combine our ways so that we would be of use to you, but...it appears that you have need of time. Would that it not <sup>be</sup> late when it is decided to act.
