- 1. Subject has been frequently mentioned over the last five or six years as an intelligence personality in Austria and Germany. His ties with the Communists have definitely been established; but recently, favorable information on subject has been supplied by a close friend and spologist for subject. Because of this new information, it has been thought advisable to synthesize all infermation available on subject and include it herewith.
- 2. Amatoli TSANOV was born 16 September 1921 in Byala Slatina, Bulgaria. He is approximately 6 feet tall, weighe 175 pounds, has brown receding hair, sometimes wears a mastache, and constantly smokes a pipe. Subject left Bulgaria and came to Visnoma in late 1939 or early 1940 to study medicine but never completed his studies. According to several sources, evaluated as 3-2, subject worked for the Germane in an intelligence capacity in Austria Suring World War II. There is a specific reference to subject haveing been trained by the Germans for parachute mission into Balgaria in 1944. Most reports on subject reflect the fact that he fled Vienna in 1945 for Immebruck, Austria where he was arrested by the French for collaborating with the Gormans. He was released in 1946 and want to work for the French Intelligence Service under whose emspices he is said to have joined the Austrian Communist Party. He engaged in samugling and blackmarket activities and sporadically studied medicine until 1950 when he dropped medicine completely. A usually reliable source stated that subject was arrested by the Austrians for sanggling in September 1953 and as of January 1955 was still in jail. He has hed several jobs and was reported in 1950 to have worked for an Italian lumber firm in Visums and after that with a chemical company as a salesman and general representative. At some unknown date after World Wer II, subject married Evalue FRIEE, and Amstrian, who had kept a home for subject at least for the previous five years at Vienna II, Krumbenngasse 1/18 (Soviet Sector). They have two children.
- 3. Subject was reportedly dropped by the French Intelligence Service in 1949. Since that time it has definitely been established that subject has worked for the Bulgarian Intelligence Service and for the intelligence service of enother unidentified Wortern power. There are unconfirmed indication that he has worked for Soviet Intelligence. Several sources state that subject is a double-crossing opportunist who will do enything to make a dollar, while other sources say that he is besically enti-Communist and that his long-range goal is the liberation of Bulgaria. In 1950, subject's father in Bulgaria was involved in an intelligence operation with a Western power and was presumably caught by the Bulgarian Security Service when the operation failed. Subject was involved in the same operation and is probably aware of his father's fate. It is possible that subject may have been correct into working for the Communists because of their control over his father.
- 4. A slose friend of subject, now living in the West and considered to be reliable, has recently supplied the following information as a rejoinder to the derogatory information given above:
  - a. Subject has been an anti-Communist since prior to World War II, belonged to the same Bulgarian anti-Communist organization as source, and after the war helped further efforts of this organization in Vienna.
  - b. Subject worked for the French Intelligence Service, joined the Austrian Communist Party, and worked for the Bulgarian Intelligence Service in Vicama, but during all this time his true loyalties were with source's Bulgarian anti-C. maunist organization and he reported all of his activities and information gained from them to source.

- c. Subject was aware that a Balgarian exile organization had collaborated in Bulgaria with the Communist regime in the early postwer period. Subsequently this organization broke with the Communists. In order to discredit subject, members of this Bulgarism exile organization exposed his activities in Vienna and spread the information that he was actually a Communist. According to source, subject has exposed himself to discredit by his attempts to gain information on the Communist; whereas in fact, he is/highl anti-Communist who has sacrificed his name to help the anti-Communist cause.
- d. Subject likes to live well, has a weakness for vomen, and his no doubt taken money from the Communists. Source him not seen subject for three years and it may be that he has by now become less militest in his anti-Commiss... However, source would be surprised if subject had become completely would and indifferent to the anti-Communist cause.
