SUBJECT: Amendment of FOA, Ivan Dimitrov DOGREV

1. It is requested that Subject's Provisional Operational Approval (C-26466) be amended to show his immediate operational use by this Division as a spotter-recruiter of Bulgarian PM prospects in the United States, Canada and Europe. Subject will meet with officers of this Division the week of 14 January, at which time we plan to authorize his trip through the eastern United States and Canada prior to his visit to Europe for purposes of spotting and developing various Bulgarian prospects for use under Project ZERHAHNTLE.

2. This Division is aware of various reports on Subject which accuse him of being a Nazi and an opportunist. Subject is known to be intensely nationalistic and anti-Communist. For these reasons he cooperated with the Germans during the occupation of Bulgaria, but this does not necessarily imply that he advocates Nazi policies as such. Furthermore, being one of the strongest Bulgarian emigre leaders, it follows naturally that from time to time derogatory reports will be submitted on Subject from dissident groups of Bulgarian emigres.
