

Translation of Letter from Ivan DOCHEV dated 22 February 1957, Detroit:

Dear L

I will be ready with my report on 2 March; however, it will be necessary to discuss a number of questions which must be resolved favorably if we are to hope for good results for the future. I will present a written report since, in spite of my desires, obstacles have appeared which need to be removed if we are to progress and get anywhere.

We will talk about it on 2 March 1957, On Friday, 1 March in the morning I will telephone you as prearranged. If we do not make connections we will meet on Saturday, 2 March at the same place after 10:00 a.m.

SE/B Comment:

- a) A source of ours in Cleveland stated on 28 February 1957 that Angel BEZEV, L now in Lackawanna, described a meeting in that town presided over by DOCHEV at which he tried to collect data on each NF member, as he said, "for a dossier." The Lackawanna NF people were not happy with this development.
- b) Radi SLAVOV, our W/T candidate told the same source that DOCHEV had confided to SLAVOV that he was getting U.S. Government financial support for his travels and that he had been charged by the U.S. Government with locating and building up a cadre for future operations into Bulgaria.
