- 1. Reference is made to Provisional Operational Approval granted Subject 14 January 1957 for use as a spotter-recruiter.
- 2. This is to advise that, Security Office has completed name checks on Subject under the name furnished your office. These checks developed some information from ONI and the State Department which may or may not pertain to Subject. In addition, the FBI name check on Subject referred to data regarding one Athanas ZAMPHIROFF, which was furnished this Agency on 9 April 1954. It is not known whether or not this person is identical with the Atanas ZAMPIROV who is mentioned on page 3 of SE-2/CE memorandum dated 13 November 1953.
- 3. It is requested that you review at this office, the ONI and State reports on Subject. In addition, it is also requested that you advise this office of the significance of the FBI data regarding Athanas ZAMPHIROFF. This FBI information is not in CI/OA's files.
- l. For your information, the Security Office has developed information which indicated that Subject may have possibly used the last name of DOCHEFF. The Security Office is conducting additional name checks on Subject under this possible alias. Subject will be considered for full Operational Approval upon completion of these checks and your review of the above mentioned information.
