LETTER FROM GOMACE TO C J DATED 24 JANUARY 1958

As I told you before, I and the people in our organisation insisted most emphatically to the King that he make a decision in regard to the setting up of a Bulgarian Representation Abroad before our Congress in Rev York since the decisions to be taken at the convention would depend on his answer. I now bring you the news that the King has decided to set up and announce a Representation before our convention. This was transmitted today by Esstev who had visited Volehev in Munich and both of them wrote to me. The King has accepted that which we had insisted on and had made a decision. Since various individuals and circles had conveyed to the King the idea that the Bulgarian Estional Fr. it was trying to take over the MRA, the King, in order not to be accused that he had capitulated to the BMA, the King, in order not to be accused that he had capitulated to the BMA, asked Statev to put other persons in the Representation in place of Volehev and myself. If this were done, the King would be ready to announce the Representation before our convention. I indicated my agreement and so did Volehev. The question is thus resolved and the Representation will have the following composition:

- a. Secretarist: Khristo Statev, Alexander Hikolaev (from Brazil) and Colomel M. (sie) Kostov (from Italy).
- b. A council of approximately 15 persons which will include Dr. George Paprikov and Dr. Kalin Koychev from the ENF in America, Dr. Alexander Lyubenov from the ENF in Germany, Ivan Denohev from the ENF in America, and Dr. Atamas Kafelsov from the ENF in Spain.

The above Representation will be announced as a temporary one and an attempt will be made sconest to find a way of attracting other people and reconstructing the council. I will try to send you any new details when I receive them.
