

Letter received from GOMACE on 20 June 1958 by []:

Following are the points discussed briefly:

1. Rumors that BAIKUSHEV was going to Greece to work under (American) military sponsorship are false. He is not going.
2. GOMACE, while in New York in early June talked with some of his friends, and he says that everything is just fine now, i.e. rumors to the effect that he no longer commands respect from BNF members and miscellaneous accusations against him. (CO Note: This of course isn't true. In reality GOMACE has lost face and does no longer command respect among BNF members).
3. GOMACE requested that we send \$50. for support of Todor TODOROV's child immediately and on a monthly basis thereafter prior to the child's trip back to Bulgaria to live with it's grandparents. Support would continue after that point also. (CO Note: We have not indicated that we would support the child here in the states, only perhaps if the child can be sent back to Bulgaria)
4. Maria Louisa, princess (Bulg royal family) arrived in Toronto with her husband, Prince Lininger (spelling?) and the reception was very informal and nothing special was planned.
5. In general GOMACE tells us to forget all the things we hear about him, accusations, etc. to the effect that he has lost face, that he stirs up trouble, his competition with [], etc.
