  BURIED NEARBY AND THEIR GRAVE-SITE WAS ENCLOSED WITH A FENCE OF
  BAMBOO BRANCHES. (FIELD COMMENT: WAS SHOWN THE JOINT PERSONNEL
  RECOVERY CENTER (JPRC) ALBUM OF MISSING AND CAPTURED PERSONN L IN

- THE JPRC, WHICH COMMENTED AS FOLLOWS: CORRELATION OF THIS REPORT

  VINSON, USAF, ON 24 APRIL 1968. THE AIRCRAFT OF LT PACKER AND
  LTC VINSON WAS ON A NIGHT MISSION IN THE VICINITY OF THE ARCA MENTIONED IN THIS REPORT. DURING A TARGET RUN, AND EXPLOSION WAS SEEN
  BY THE WINGMAN BUT NO CONTACT VIA RADIO WAS ESTABLISHED. O CHUTES
  WERE SEEN AND NO BEEPERS WERE HEARD. BOTH CREW MEN ARE PRESENTLY
  CARRIED AS KISSING IN ACTION.)
