AN INFORMATION REPORT, NOT FINALLY EVALUATED INTELLIGENCE REPORT NO. CONSIDERATE DATE DISTRETZ DETUETX ETTE 2 october 1972 NORTH VIETNAM COUNTRY AUGUST OR SEPTEMEER 1967 100 SIGHTING OF A U.S. PRISONER OF WAR IN HUU QUAN SUBJECT VILLAGE, HAIPHONG MUNICIPALITY ACR SOURCE SIGHTED AN AMERICAN PRISONER OF WAR (POW) IN HUU QUAN VILLAGE, THUY NGUYEN DISTRICT, HAIPHONG MUNICIPALITY, NORTH VIETNAM (NVN), AT ABOUT 1500 HOURS ONE DAY IN AUGUST OR SEPTEMBER 196 THE PILOT'S PLANE HAD BEEN SHOT DOWN ABOUT TWO KILOMETERS APPROVED FOR RELEASE, 8 STATE

FROM WHERE SIGNTED THE PILOT.

- VILLAGE, ONE KILOMETER FROM HUU QUAN VILLAGE, HEARD THE SOUNDS OF EGMEING AND ANTIAIR CRAFT ARTILLERY (AAA) FIRE AT ABOUT 1400 HOURS. AN HOUR LATER, AND OTHER PEOPLE FROM THE VILLAGE RUSHED TO HUU DUAN VILLAGE TO SEE THE CAPTURED PILOT. THEY NOTICED THAT TWO OUT OF EIGHT 122MM AAA GUNS IN HUU QUAN VILLAGE WERE DAMAGED AND THAT 13 MEMBERS OF THE ANTIAIR CRAFT COMPANY IN THE VILLAGE HAD BEEN KILLED. THE VILLAGERS WERE TRYING TO BEAT THE POW, BUT SOME NORTH VIETNAMESE ARMY (NVA) SOLDIERS EXPLAINED TO THEM THAT THE POW WAS VERY IMPORTANT TO THE NVN GOVERNMENT. THE SPECIATORS WERE TOLD THAT THE POW HAD SHOT AND SERIOUSLY WOUNDED A MILITIANAN IN HUU QUAN VILLAGE AND HAD BEEN BEATEN UP BY THE OTHER MILITIAMEN. AT APOUT 1530 MOURS, TWO NVA SOLDIERS ARMED VITH AK RIFLES AND A SOVIET WITH A CAMERA ARRIVED IN A SOVIET-MADE VEHICLE FROM
- A. COMMENT: DURING INTERROGATION, WAS SHOWN THE JOINT PERSONNEL RECOVERY CENTER (JPRC) ALBUM OF MISSING AND CAPTURED PERSONNEL IN SOUTHEAST ASIA, BUT HE WAS UNABLE TO MAKE ANY IDENTIFICATION. THE JPRC, HOWEVER, EVALUATES THE INFORMATION IN THIS REPORT AS FOLLOWS: "THIS REPORT CORRELATES QUITE WELL WITH JPRC RECORDS ON LODR MILTON JAMES VESCEL IOUS, WHO WAS DOVINED BY ANA AT THE LOCATION GIVEN BY THIS REPORT AT

- VILLAGE, ONE KILOMETER FROM HUU QUAN VILLAGE, HEARD THE SOUNDS OF ECMEING AND ANTIALRORAFT ARTILLERY (AAA) FIRE AT ABOUT 1400 HOURS. AN HOUR LATER, AND OTHER PEOPLE FROM THE VILLAGE RUSHED TO HUU QUAN VILLAGE TO SEE THE CAPTURED PILOT. THEY NOTICED THAT TWO OUT OF EICHT 1000MM AAA GUNS IN HUU QUAN VILLAGE WERE DAMAGED AND THAT 13 MEMBERS OF THE ANTIALRORAFT COMPANY IN THE VILLAGE HAD BEEN KILLED. THE SPECTATORS WERE TOLD THAT THE POW HAD SHOT AND SERIOUSLY WOUNDED A MILITIANAN. IN HUU QUAN VILLAGE AND HAD BEEN BEATEN UP BY THE OTHER MILITIAMEN. AT AFOUT 1530 YOURS, TWO NVA SOLDIERS ARMED VITH AK RIFLES AND A SOVIET WITH A CAMERA ARRIVED IN A SOVIET-MADE VEHICLE FROM
- 3. THE PILOT HAD A HEAD WOUND AND WAS COVERED WITH SAND AND DIRT. HE WORE PLUE PANTS, A WHITE, BLOODSTAINED SHIRT AND NO SHOES. HE WAS ABOUT 35 YEARS OLD, 1.80 METERS IN-HEIGHT, ABOUT 80 KILOS IN WEIGHT AND HAD A RUDDY COMPLEXION. HIS ATTITUDE WAS HOSTILE. HIS MAUSER PISTOL HAD BEEN TAKEN BY MILITIAMEN IN HUU QUAN VILLAGE. THE POW WAS BELIEVED TO BE A FIELD GRADE OFFICER BECAUSE HIS PARACHUTE WAS RED.
- A. COMMENT: DURING INTERROGATION, WAS SHOWN THE JOINT PERSONNEL RECOVERY CENTER (JPRC) ALBUM OF MISSING AND CAPTURED PERSONNEL IN SOUTHEAST ASIA, BUT HE WAS UNABLE TO MAKE ANY IDENTIFICATION. THE JPRC, HOWEVER, EVALUATES THE INFORMATION IN THIS REPORT AS FOLLOWS: "THIS REPORT CORRELATES QUITE WELL WITH JPRC RECORDS ON LODR MILTON JAMES VESCEL IOUS, WHO WAS DOWNED BY AAA AT THE LOCATION GIVEN BY THIS REPORT AT
