1. AT 1000 HOURS ON ABOUT 20 DECEMBER 1972. SAN TWO U. S. PRISONERS OF WAR (POWS) ON PHO HO STREET (XJ199266), DAI BAI HAMLET, DAI BAI VILLAGE, GIA LUONG DISTRICT. HA BAC PROVINCE, NORTH VIETNAM (NVN). PEOPLE WHO HAD WITNESSED THE CAPTURE SAID THAT THE POWS HAD BEEN CAPTURED ABOUT FIVE MINUTES EARLIER WHILE THEY WERE WALKING DOWN A ROAD AT XJ206262 IN QUANG BO HAMLET. QUANG BO VILLAGE, GIA LUONG DISTRICT. AND HEADED IN THE DIRECTION OF DAI BAL VILLAGE. THE POHS HAD BEEN SPOTTED AN HOUR BEFORE THEIR CAPTURE, BUT THE LOCAL PEOPLE THOUGHT THEY WERE RUSSIANS. THEY WERE SUBSEQUENTLY REPORTED TO AND CAPTURED BY THE GIA LUONG DISTRICT. PUBLIC SECURITY SERVICE (PSS). THE POWS WERE TAKEN TO THE PHO HO STREET PSS STATION. AND ABOUT 30 MINUTES LATER WERE TAKEN AWAY IN A GREEN PSS CAR AND HEADED IN THE DIRECTION OF HANDI. THE PEOPLE WHO WITNESSED THE CAPTURE ALSO SAID THAT THEY THOUGHT THE POWS WERE PILOTS FROM U.S. PLANES, WHICH HAD BOMBED HANDI FROM 2000 HOURS, 18 DECEMBER, TO 0500 HOURS, 19 DECEMBER 1972, SINCE THEY HAD SEEN TWO OR THREE OF THE PLANES HIT BY ANTIAIRCRAFT.
